15) ICT Facilities

These facilities are connected with Local Area Network (LAN). Our college has also provided Wi-Fi connectivity for the internet use. College has CCTV security system and Biometric Machine for time to time work, safe and protection.

Some Important Rules and Regulations for Admitted Students

- 8) It is necessary to return the books in the library in time
- 9) It is necessary to use the books in the library carefully

If a student behaves against the above rules, she will be punished accordingly and session will not be sanctioned and she will not be allowed to appear for the examination.

Rules for student behaviour
